The Parliament of Australia enacts:

Part 1—Preliminary

1 Short title

This Act is the High Speed Rail Investment Act 2022.

2 Commencement

(1) Each provision of this Act specified in column 1 of the table commences, or is taken to have commenced, in accordance with column 2 of the table. Any other statement in column 2 has effect according to its terms.

4 Objects of this Act

The objects of this act are:

(a) To legally mandate any and all governments in power over the next 5 years to allocate spending to the creation of a High Speed Rail network.

5 Definitions

In this Act:

High Speed Rail refers to a railway running trains which exceed 350 km/h.

6 Commonwealth to be bound

(1) This Act binds the Commonwealth in all its capabilities.

7 Extension to external Territories

This Act extends to all external Territories.
