Masih Alinejad (*Persian*: مسیح علی‌نژاد, born **Masoumeh Alinejad-Ghomikolayi** (*Persian*: معصومه علی‌نژاد قمی‌کلایی), September 11, 1976^[*citation needed*]) is an **Iranian-American**^[4] journalist, author, and **women's rights** activist.^{[5][6]} Alinejad works as a presenter/producer at **Voice of America Persian News Network**, a correspondent for **Radio Farda**, a frequent contributor for **Manoto** television, and a contributing editor for *IranWire*.^[7] Alinejad focuses on criticism of the status of **human rights in Iran**, especially **women's rights**.^[8] *Time* magazine named her among its 2023 honorees for Women of the Year.^[9]
