

Executive Summary

DeepFeed is a next-generation content platform powered primarily by generative AI. It curates a stream of thought-provoking, emotionally resonant, and engaging content across multiple domains — from news and storytelling to debates and humor. Unlike traditional social media, DeepFeed reduces noise by shifting the content creation burden away from users and onto aligned AI models. This enables higher-quality, more consistent, and more meaningful engagement at scale.



Problem

Traditional social media platforms rely heavily on user-generated content, leading to:

- Noise and low signal-to-noise ratio
- Inconsistent content quality (dreck)
- Toxic engagement loops
- Algorithmic amplification of outrage or sensationalism

There is growing user fatigue with traditional platforms — and a desire for curated quality, emotional intelligence, and sanity.

Solution

DeepFeed inverts the model:

- AI-generated content populates the feed (guided by user profiles, interests, moods, trends)
- User interactions remain (likes, comments, prompts, reactions), but influence is softened by curation logic
- Human-in-the-loop moderation ensures tone, safety, and relevance
- Bots and characters (some persistent) simulate meaningful conversation and create storylines
- Customizable filters let users tune their feed like a mood-based instrument



Core Features

- Infinite scroll of generative content across themes: explainers, fiction, commentary, humor, debate, philosophy, etc.
- Upvote/downvote, comment, star/favorite, and remix options
- User-controlled prompt modifiers and feed filters (tone, depth, mood, length, etc.)
- Optional real-time collaboration with friends or public-facing interaction
- Thematic “subfeeds” or AI-run communities (inspired by subreddits)

Differentiation

- AI-first content ecosystem, not user-first or influencer-first
- High-quality moderation by design (distribution is tightly managed)
- Optional public-facing visibility: it can work as a private consumption tool or a semi-social one
- Lower friction for thoughtful content (no need to write for clout or approval)

Target Users

- Creatives and thinkers craving high-quality stimulus
- AI-curious users exploring augmentation tools
- Disillusioned social media users
- Niche communities who want to “tune” their corner of the internet



- Parents, educators, learners, therapists, writers, and readers
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Go-To-Market Options

- Start closed: invite-only, like early Clubhouse or Notion
 - Launch on web, optimize for mobile responsiveness
 - Target communities on Reddit, Hacker News, Mastodon, and newsletters
 - Use DeepFeed to seed its own outreach (AI-generated launch strategy!)
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Revenue Options (exploratory)

- Freemium: free users get core access; power filters, characters, and archive are premium
 - Patronage: users support AI creators, characters, or feed themes
 - API access: let others use DeepFeed-style content to populate their sites/apps
 - White-label offerings for therapists, educators, or community builders
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Next Steps

1. Prototype: Expand working local app into a hosted MVP
2. Test and tune: Small batch of test users with feedback loops
3. Define KPIs: Quality engagement over raw usage (e.g. completion, saves, remixes)
4. Explore team needs: Potential cofounders, partners, or advisors
5. Identify alignment risks: Ethics, moderation, misuse, etc.
