Death By Bikini - 12 Wins in Greece, 50%

(The following interviews took place on private beaches in Kauai, Hawaii, near the headquarters of the Death By Bikini stable. The interviews occurred approximately 17 days after UCC XII in Greece)

UCC XI in Moscow was a profitable event for Death By Bikini. In a stable which now boasts 24 members, Moscow provided 16 victories. Things weren't quite so smooth in Greece, with only 12 girls taking away a win. While some UCC stables may be content with a 50% win rate, I doubt Death By Bikini will take a "cup half full" approach to this result.

As usual, I was granted one on one interviews with all 12 winners in Greece. That would include the three new rookie winners, for whom this was only their second UCC event.

Following on from UCC XII, the Bikini girls will take part in the Fourth UCC Tournament Series. I'm intending to use this interview session to talk to some of the girls about how well they think they'll perform in The Caribbean.



In particular two women who will be Death By Bikini competitors in a non-swimsuit attire tournament.

Myla Dalbesio, will be the tenth seed in the Heavyweight Lingerie Tournament, and **Camille Kostek** will be seeded 13th in the Middleweight Workout Tournament. Both girls suffered losses in Greece.



I spoke to **Kostek** on the beach, "I'm looking forward to fighting it out in my gym gear. I'm lucky to be sponsored by Reebok and the outfit they have given me looks so sick. Yeah, it'd be cool to fight in a different bikini, but at least in the workout tournament I won't have to face any of my stablemates."

Dalbesio saw the upcoming tournament in the same light, "Not having to worry about fighting a friend makes this tournament a lot easier to focus on. In the previous three tournaments my first round

fight has always been against another DBB member, and I've lost each and every time. It sucks to go out in the first round."

"But this time I'll be going it alone and my first match will be against **Katy Perry**. I've had a terrible run of losses this year, I really do hope that in my lingerie I'll be able to get myself back on track."

Dalbesio isn't the only Bikini fighter who is struggling to find winning form in 2021, **Rose Bertram** lost again in Greece. "At least I made it to the third round against **Ameerah al-Taweel**, but at the moment I really do suck and I'm super pissed off. **Alexandra Daddario** is my first round tournament opponent, holy shit I better beat her."

There were other lowlights in Greece, **Chrissy Teigen** lost to a submissive move from **Ana de Armas**. But at least she isn't the lowest ranking DBB member, that unfortunate title goes to Dalbesio.

Jessica Gomes failed to win against Jisoo from Blackpink, she is however seeded third in her upcoming tournament. There's every chance she can pick up some valuable wins against the other featherweight swimsuit fighters.

Barbara Palvin and **Kate Bock** recorded losses at UCC XI, both ladies losing to fellow stablemates. Something that we're all getting far too used to.

The two biggest and brightest Death By Bikini fighters to drop the ball in Greece were **Lais Ribeiro** and **Robyn Lawley**. Before chatting to the dozen winners, I spoke briefly to both of them.

Lawley, "I'm frustrated. Frustrated with a capital F. The two losses in a row to Kylie Jenner hurt, but I was sure I could at least win against Eugenie Bouchard. Fuck, was I ever wrong. I may have lasted five rounds, but for what? I was well and truly beaten in Greece. Now the official ranking has me just in the top 20 and I won't be heading into my tournament as top seed. I've given that up to Kate Upton. Is there a silver lining in any of this? I don't think so."





Riberio wasn't any happier, "I feel like **Julianne Hough** just played me in Mykonos. I need to win my tournament. I can't let someone like **Emily Ratajkowski** beat me in the final round. I need to win and I'll be giving this event every single thing I have. Just watch me."

There were other Death By Bikini members who were unable to win in Greece, but for now my focus would turn to the dozen women who did win. I began my usual walk along the Pacific coastline and found them, one by one.



Kate Upton



"Although the stable may not have been as productive in Greece as we were in Moscow, I'm still happy with the results. I'm 100% happy with my last three matches and I think I've finally managed to get that monkey off my back. And by monkey, I mean Victoria Silvstedt."

"I hope to avoid facing her during the Swimsuit tournament. I'm the top seed and this feels like my best chance for taking home a tournament title. Of course tournaments are very hard to predict. They're extremely physical and taxing on the body, no one walks away from a UCC tournament without a few bumps and bruises. Some don't even walk away at all."

"My game plan is to take this one fight at a time.


Eliminate Debbe Dunning as quickly as possible and then focus on round two. No doubt I'll have to fight one of my stablemates, but at least there's only one Centerfold Angel to deal with."

"Maybe this event will be Silvstedt's last UCC tournament ever. Even old apes need to retire at some point."





"Shit."




"Now I'm in for more shit."

"Jessica. Jessica Weaver. I didn't know who you were before our fight in Nafplio and I don't know who you are after our fight."


"Basically, I just don't care. You are forgettable."

"Not."




