Call to order - Barbara Orlando

With a quorum of Board members present, the February 2023 Board meeting was called to order at 1:00 PM by President Barbara Orlando.

New locations for the 2023 board meetings have been sent out to the board.

Old Business:

- Vote on tournament rules, referee rules and rules of etiquette
- Plans and feedback from CBOD regarding the new courts. These plans are preliminary and subject to change. Next meeting Barbara hopes to have someone here to give an update. Nothing set in stone yet.
- A motion was made by Wayne Weiler to accept the Tournament Rules and George Paris seconded the motion with the Bocce Board approving the Tournament Rules with a show of hands.
- A discussion ensued regarding placement of bocce balls prior to throwing out the pallino as time is running out. It was clarified that the balls just must be out of the way (balls must be removed from the active end where the pallino is going). Bocce balls do not have to be racked.
- George will check to be sure this issue is included in the Tournament Rules.

New Business:

Patti Smith will oversee the annual shirt order. Helen suggested to put merchandise we currently have on hand out for sale during bootcamp. There was a suggestion to sell the merchandise we have on hand during the last day of boot camp. Patti will contact Bill Masching prior to his departure for details and do an inventory of merchandise on hand. It was agreed to start the orders for merchandise soon, prior to Spring Round Robin.
