

Course Title:	Emergency Medicine

The course presents the tools for students to understand the importance of pre-hospital care and delivers a thorough understanding of the proper use of medical equipment necessary to provide appropriate care. The competencies in this course are aligned with the National Standard Curriculum, Common Core State Standards, and the California Career Technical Education Model Curriculum Standards. There is also an emphasis on college and career readiness skills such as <u>team work</u> effective communication, professionalism, and medical ethics.</p>
