Welcome to the Park Valley Church Disaster Relief Team! New members should complete the Section 1 checklist below. New members deploying immediately upon joining the DRT, complete the Section 1 “New Member” checklist and Section 2: “New Member Deployment Readiness” checklist below.

- ☐ From the team website link above, click the “[Team Member Resources](#)” tab and save this page to your device's home screen for quick and frequent access. Take note of how to access the team calendar.
- ☐ On the “[Team Member Resources](#)” site in the top area called the “New Members Section” - view the PVC-DRT Overview PPT, and review the PVC-DRT Handbook Section 1 & Appendix 1.
- ☐ Register for PVC Grow 101 - A requirement to be deployable (enrollment in the next class satisfies the requirement to be deployable). [Park Valley Church Grow Classes](#)
- ☐ Attend team meetings - Generally the first Saturday of the even months 0800-1000 hours (February, April, June, August, October, December).

Section 2 - New Member Deployment Readiness Checklist

This section is for new members who are preparing for deployment.

- ☐ Complete the steps in Section 1.
- ☐ The Go-Kit List – Begin to build out your Go-Kit. This may take some time, so it's best to start early. [PVC-DRT Go-Kit List](#)
- ☐ GMRS License - The DRT uses GMRS radios to communicate while on deployment. The FCC website is challenging to navigate, so use the included link to apply. [How To Get A GMRS License THE EASY WAY! | 4K](#) It will help if you open two windows to be able to pause the video as you pause the video to complete the outlined steps.
- ☐ Email a copy of your GMRS License to DRT@parkvalleychurch.com
- ☐ Text or email a passport-style photo (no hats or sunglasses with a neutral background) using your device to be used for your deployment ID.
- ☐ View the Deployment Preparation PPT.
- ☐ On the [“Team Member Resources”](#) site in the middle area called “Deployment Readiness Requirement” - View all of the safety videos: High Risk Low Frequency Risk Awareness, Orientation, Deployment Safety, 3M N95 Fitting, and 3M Half Mask Fitting. Complete the Deployment Compliance Checklist. All of these are required for deployment eligibility.
