GROUP AGREEMENT

At the start of each semester, we will create a group agreement, otherwise known as a code of conduct that has been written collectively. (As a reference, we might refer to the School for Poetic Computation's code of conduct).

- ★ Be kind
- ★ Be respectful to: each other, the work, the space
- ★ Embrace awkward silences
- ★ Ask clarifying questions
- ★ We will wear masks in class
- ★ Food/drink: Do we want to be able to eat in class?
 - o yes
- ★ Photography: Are we allowed to take screenshots of classmates and post them on social media?
 - o yes
- ★ Participation: raising hands, and calling out
- ★ Ask each other for help first
- ★ Listening to music with headphones during studio time
- ★ Key points by the designer before a critique that they specifically would like feedback on
