## How does the Auction work?

There are two parts to the overall Auction Effort: the "Main Event," happening at Burke on Saturday, April 26 and an Online Auction which will take place April 15-22.

The in-person event will be a feast for the senses – a night of merriment, jesters, and noble pursuits – all in service of raising vital funds for Financial Aid. There will be plenty of comedy and entertainment, while we raise critical funds for Financial Aid through Raffles and Live Auction opportunities. You can also make a tax-deductible donation directly to the Financial Aid program during the "paddle-raise" portion of the Virtual Event. The Online Auction is like eBay: you bid from your computer or phone and get an email if you've been outbid and/or you win an item.
