- Students earn <u>24 credits</u> in order to graduate at WHS. The <u>High School and Beyond Plan</u>, (activities & progress each year) helps to determine a <u>Personalized Pathway Requirement (PPR)</u>. The PPR are related courses leading to a specific post high school career or educational outcome chosen by the student based on interests. They are part of Elective credit required.
- Art, PE & CTE can be taken in any year. If you are planning Cascadia Technical Academy or Running Start, it's a good idea to get PE and Art completed in 9th and 10th grade.
- 4-year University Admission Requirements: 2.0 credits (2 years) of the same World Language, Algebra II, and a senior year math-based course (Pre-Calculus, AP Calculus, Personal Finance, Applied Math, Chemistry, AP Physics, Physical Science or AP Computer Science Principles). Highly selective schools may require additional science or social studies).
