*2 ladies with gunshots wounds (accidentally discharged weapon)- treated and discharged.

* Title IX case-incident posted on social media, case fell through the cracks, students protested.

*Faculty do not always handle ADA accommodations appropriately.

* Gun violence safety-President Allen will meet with 10 students over the summer to discuss the issue.

* Nursing program- no longer accredited because students have not hit 80% in the licensure rate. The program is too small. The college has reimagined pathways to Allied Health and is considering pathways to Physical Therapy and Occupational Therapy school.

Good News:

- Student Internships are growing. Partners are Northrop Grumman, Tysons, Meta, SAP, Columbia University, Temple, Penn, Colby AI center.
- Applications are up by 40%
- More than 50% of students earned a merit scholarship.
- 1854 Fund-please donate \$2,000/year.
- Buildings and property renovations:
 - *Amos Hall-Renovate and expand- store and curate Art, lodging available
 - * Vail Hall -Renovation fall 2024
 - Cresson Hall- Renovation- 24 beds on the 1st floor, houses a research center and the underground railroad.
 - *Manuel Rivero Hall- closed for 2.5 years- renovation- increase in arena and rental space.
- New Micro credentials available at Lincoln through Coursera- includes contractor programs.
