It's the Copy takeaway: When looking for a creative solution, pay attention to what's happening around you.

In my case, I was walking and caught myself paying attention to my surroundings. Was I eavesdropping? Yes, we all do it.

You're a writer in a public place surrounded by different people everyone has his own view of this world.

A phrase may be overhead at the table next to you. A sign at an aisle end cap catches your attention. A billboard about motorcycle insurance sparks an idea

These signs are all around us all the time

Have you ever read a book and found a quote that makes you double-take?

Or watch a movie or show, and a line makes us pause and rewind four, or five times because it inspired a great line of a copy?

Being more aware and being open to finding clues helps you never run out of creative ideas

If you aren't looking for clues, they will walk right passed you. And you are back to staring at a blank screenwriting
