

Peace of God Scriptures and Prayers!

1. **Philippians 4:6-7** - "Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."

God may Your peace flow through me now, calming every storm in my heart. I rest far above every care of this world knowing You care for me.

2. **2 Thessalonians 3:16** - "Now may the Lord of peace himself give you peace at all times in every way. The Lord be with you all."

Peace of God, rule in my heart this day. I cast all my cares onto You, Jesus. Your Word is my anchor, keeping me steady in every situation.

3. **John 14:27** - "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid."

No matter what happens around me, I command my soul to remain at peace. I rest because I trust You are working on my behalf, even in the chaos of this world.

6. **John 16:33** - "I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. but take heart; I have overcome the world."

7. **Daniel 10:19** - "'Don't be afraid,' he said, 'for you are very precious to God. Peace! Be encouraged! Be strong!' As he spoke these words to me, I suddenly felt stronger and said to him, 'Please speak to me, my lord, for you have strengthened me.'"

I refuse to be restless. My confidence is in Your faithfulness. Free me from the torment of anxious thoughts. May your peace silence every voice of fear and doubt.

8. **Isaiah 54:10** - "Though the mountains may depart and the hills be removed, my steadfast love shall not depart from you, and my covenant of peace shall not be removed, says the Lord, who has compassion on you."

My life is in God's hands. I am not shaken by the world. I am held in Your firm embrace. Your peace is mine now and forever.

Prayer for Peace:

Father God, I receive Your peace which passes all human understanding. Fear, I take authority over you in the name of Jesus. I resist, rebuke, and bind torment.
