-MOY Data Review:

SEL/Behavior: Our goal is to reduce by 50%

BOY: 61% major referrals during lunch and recess, MOY: 38%, EOY (as of April 30th) 43%

Action steps: 3 of our TA's have been trained in Recess Rocks, rolling out Ruler, more supervision during recess

Math: Students in the red BOY: 15%, MOY 6% // Green: BOY: 19%, MOY: 47%

ELA: (NWEA) BOY: 72% on grade level, MOY: 79%

Attendance: 7% BOY, 10% MOY -not trajecting in the correct direction for EOY

-Action steps: Recognizing students who are consistently hear, direct communication between teachers and families, nudge letters, updating data in RIDE dashboard, increase family response rates, cougar cash, morning meetings, student participation during morning announcements, reviewing school-wide behavior expectations, continue with student council, next year look at attendance needs during MTSS and tier attendance concerns

Celebrations: Our first SIT meeting with student representation... YAY! PTO is getting ready for the Trunk or Treat. New spirit wear is coming soon.

Student celebrations: "Math is going well."

Public forum: How has the transition been going with the HV students?

Grounds update: Our garden area has been cleaned out and mulched. Each grade level is going to have their own bed. A parent is donating tulip bulbs for first grade to plant in their gardens. Flowers were transplanted from HVES. A new plaque was placed near the bell from the old Ashaway school.

Parents report that the email format is working.

We had our first whole school assembly introducing our new Student of the Month. Each month a student will be chosen by their peers to be student of the month. Students will be recognized at our monthly assemblies and will receive a special t-shirt and GOLDEN cougar cash (worth 10 cougar dollars).

Our student council is up and running. They are helping with our school initiatives and are helping with the school store. See [PBIS.org](http://PBIS.org) to get information on why we do the school store. Teachers suggested having a school store week, where each grade level shops on a specific day of the week, first thing in the morning.

Reviewed Survey Works student data. Absenteeism went up the most over the last year (39%- up 10%). We also went down 18% in school engagement in the last year. School climate went up 2% , school safety went up 9%. Parent responses: Spec ed services & absenteeism went up. School improvement and family engagement went down.

DESSA Mini will roll out in the near future (most likely this year). Teachers will fill out a SEL screener on each student with 6 competencies: optimistic thinking, relationship skills, self management, responsibility, social awareness, self awareness.

Question: Will parents get input? Will parents be notified if a child is flagged? \*Parents have the option to opt their child out and receive information on that.

Student members filled out AES “Glows and Grows-” What’s going well? We’re kind and “paying attention,” testing, specials, math, reading What do we need to improve upon? Less homework, more recess, handwriting

SIP- reviewed our vision and mission statements. ELA goal, Math goal, and an attendance goal
