- 1. What is the character's name?
 - a. Johnny Dandelion
- 2. Briefly describe the character:
 - a. Elf street samurai/decker. Views shadowrunning as a job, and he's not necessarily good at it. Neither at being a street samurai nor a decker. What age and race are the character? How do they express their gender?
 - b. His late 20s, he's an elf. Identifies as male, but isn't really into old school masculinity. His name, Dandelion reflects this, as him picking the name was a coping mechanism against being bullied (like, "yeah, I'm an elf, and not very manly, whatcha do about it, chummer, call me dandelion? Joke's on you, cuz that's my name. Also, I'm shoving the barrel of this smg right up your ass)
- 3. Could you please describe the character's hair (color and style), eyes, face shape, and facial hair (if applicable)?
 - a. He has a classic, punkish undercut on one side (where the datajack port is), black hair, about shoulder length. He has a native american heritage, but beyond that, I never thought about his features.
- 4. What is the character wearing? (please describe color as well as style)
 - a. 80s sleeveless band shirt, combat boots, and a long, purple trenchcoat with a hex pattern (the minimalist, sci fi kind)
- 5. Please describe the character's gear (weapons, armor, other gear that they are wearing or carrying)
 - a. Has a chrome left arm with a built in smg and a not so state-of-the art deck, also uses an AR. He's a hobby photographer (not very good at that either), and uses a very old polaroid camera. Oh, and it was originally for 5th ed, but this campaign I get to play in will be 3rd, so I rewrote the character for that edition, meaning his cyberdeck looks less an ipad and more like a c64.
- 6. If you have a preference, please describe how the character should be posed
 - a. He's a bit all over the place, trying to shoot with his gun while fiddling with the cables coming from his deck, also trying to not break his camera hanging around his neck. That sort of thing.
- 7. Do you have a preference for the background/foreground in which the character will be drawn?
 - a. Not really. Urban, I guess.
