

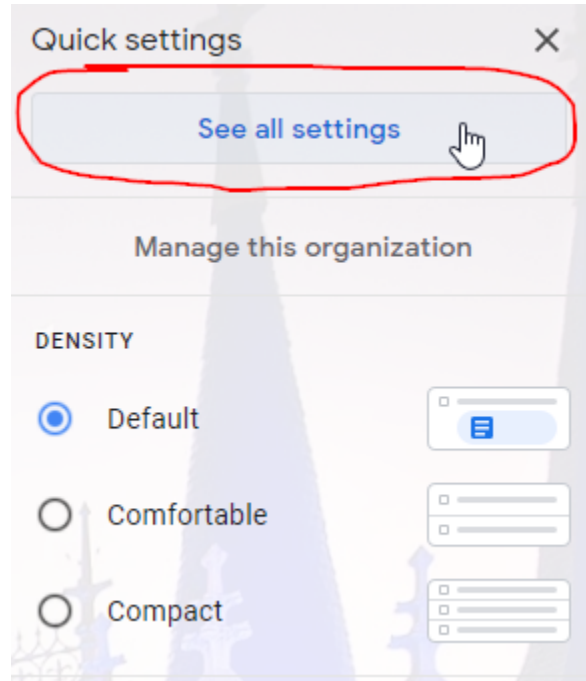

## Filter Messages To Primary Inbox

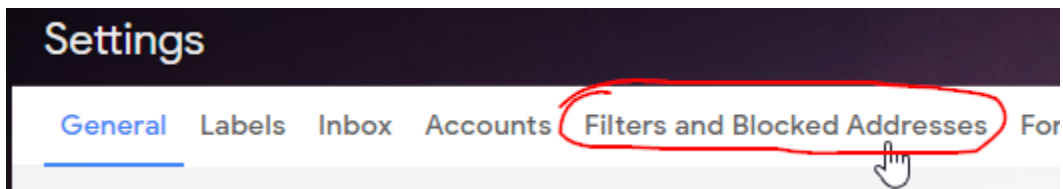
1. Log into Gmail.
2. Click on your Settings COG.



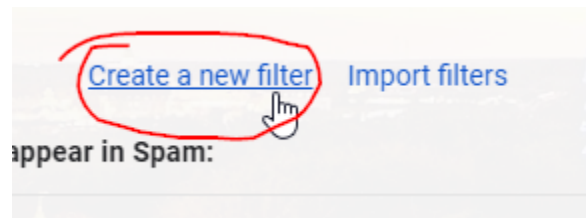
3. Select "See all settings".



4. Select "Filters and Blocked Addresses" from the tabs at the top.

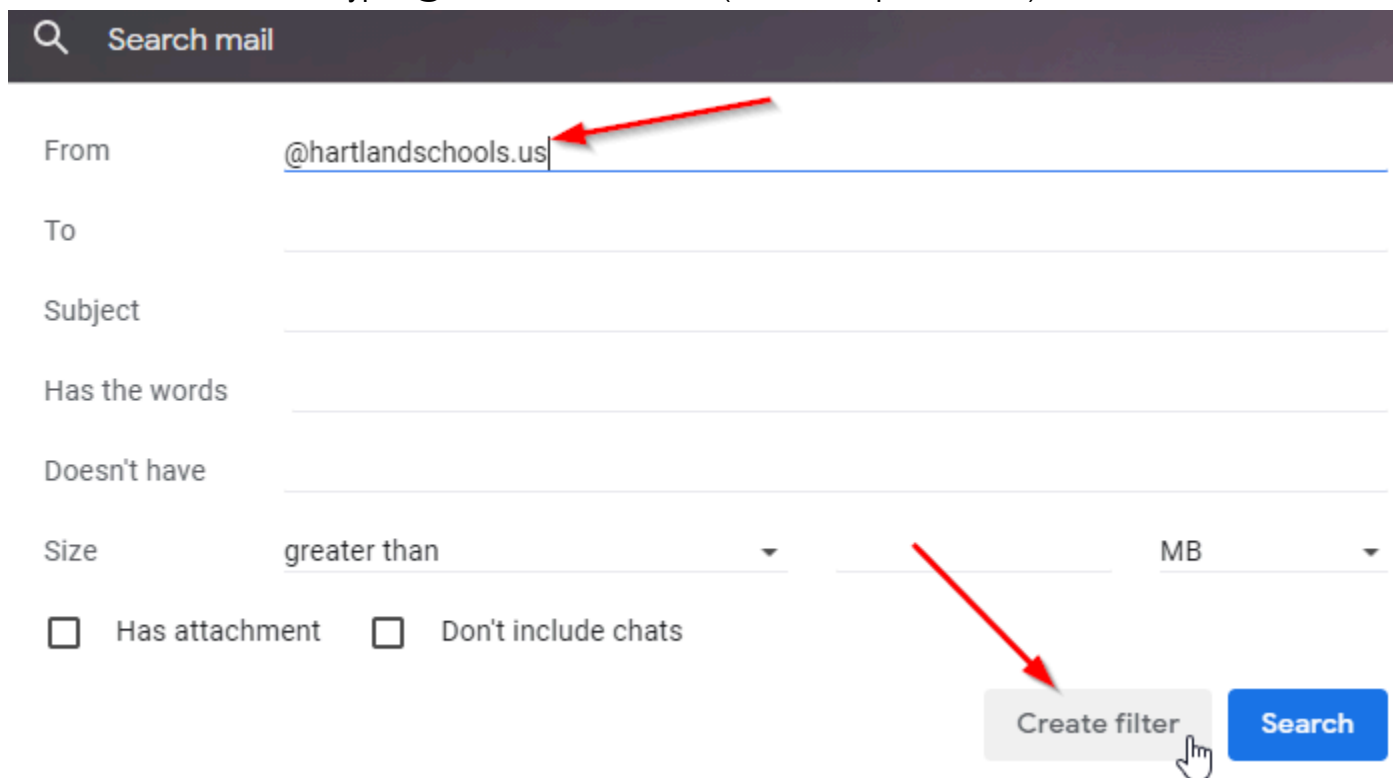


5. Find the "Create a new filter" link and click on it.

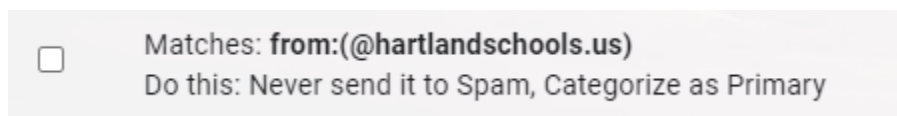

9. Click in the checkboxes “Never send it to Spam”, and “Categorize as:” and select the dropdown arrow selecting “Primary”.

10. Click the “Create filter” button.
