2023-24 Season Tracking Definitions

Passing Definitions

Shot Assist - A pass completed to the shooter within five seconds of an unblocked shot attempt.

Shot Creation Type – A categorization of what context the unblock shot attempt occurred in.

Cycle – A shot from more than three seconds of non-rush offensive zone time.

Faceoff – A shot occurring within three seconds of a faceoff.

Forecheck – A shot occurring within three seconds of a change of possession in the offensive zone or a puck recovery.

Rush – A shot occurring between the time of a zone entry and the time the offensive team crosses the goal line with the puck or defers their opportunity to take a shot by setting up as a unit.

Off the Pass – A shot that occurs within one second of the pass completion.

Off the Stick – A shot that is taken that is not off the pass.

Puck Recovery – The result of a shot attempt that does not result in a game stoppage.

Rebound – When the offensive team is able to recover the shot within the bounds of the faceoff dots and top of the circles and is able to follow up with a shot attempt within three seconds.

Possession Recovery – When the offensive team is able to recover the shot but is unable to produce a rebound shot attempt based on either the physical location or presence of the opponents.

Possession Loss – When the defensive team is able to recover the shot.
