Senior Awards Day and Picnic, Monday, May 19:

The Awards Day ceremony will be in the Biddle Auditorium; starting at 9:00am. Attendance is required. You will report to the Lunchroom at 8:00 am, sign in with your Panther Sponsor and line up. You will wear your robes, stoles, cords and pins, but NO CAPS. Appropriate attire is required for this event as it is considered dress rehearsal for graduation.

Senior Picnic will be at The Alley from 12 noon to 2pm, following the Awards Day ceremony. You are responsible for your own transportation to and from The Alley. Pizza, drinks, and bowling will be provided for SHS SENIORS. The event is not open for parents, siblings or students from other schools or other grades.

Graduation Practice, Wednesday, May 21

Attendance is MANDATORY for participation in graduation

You will be transported on buses to the Pete Mathews Coliseum at Jacksonville University. Arrive to our High School Auditorium by 3:00pm to meet your Panther Sponsor. After taking attendance, we will board the buses, travel to JSU, run the entire program and bring you back to our High School. DO NOT bring your cap and gown.

Graduation, Friday, May 23, 4:00pm

You are responsible for your own transportation to and from the Pete Mathews Coliseum at Jacksonville State for Graduation. **You will arrive by 3:00pm** and meet your Panther Sponsor on the Soccer Field. (In the case of poor weather, we will meet in the lobby of the coliseum). Appropriate attire is required for this event.

Appropriate attire for Awards Day and Graduation:

Ladies: A dress or dress pants and top is allowed. Your white collar should be attached to your robe, unless you have earned a honors stole or officer stole. No flip flops.

Gentlemen: Dress pants and dress shoes are required, with a collared shirt and tie. You may wear a bow-tie if you choose.

Caps will NOT be decorated. Make sure your tassel is attached.

Credit Recovery:

Seniors that are lacking required credits for graduation will be placed in Credit Recovery. Administration will have details about the availability and guidelines.

Chromebook and technology return- May 8th:

After you complete your last exam your Chromebook, charger, and case will be turned in to Mrs. Brewer in the Learning Commons. Any damages or missing items will be charged to you. All personal stickers or others items must be removed.

Diploma and Documents:

Your diploma, final transcript, report card, certificates and health forms will be distributed after the graduation ceremony concludes. You will meet your Panther Sponsor and sign for your packet.

Transcripts:

Continue to use Parchment through the school website link to request all transcripts leading up to and following graduation.
