

LARP COR Fireside Chats: Anti-Harassment Policy

Attendees are expected to be respectful of the digital space, their fellow attendees, and the event organizers. While respectful discussion that may include disagreements is encouraged, and accidents happen, harassment of any kind will not be tolerated at this event. For the purposes of this event, harassment is defined as the following:

- A verbal or physical action that disregards or intentionally breaches the comfort of either the intended target or a bystander. This can include written or verbal comments, displayed images, or gestures about someone's physicality, emotions, history, etc, including but not limited to: gender, gender expression, sex, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, body size, race, ethnicity, place of origin, age, religion, socioeconomic status, genetic information, HIV/AIDS or other STI status, relationship status, marital status, medical condition, military and/or veteran status, and/or status as a victim of domestic violence, assault, or stalking.
- Intimidation (physical, written, or verbal), abusive behavior, body or gender policing, non-consensual photography or recording, and unwanted physical or sexual attention or contact.

We are committed to centering the safety of our more marginalized attendees over the comfort of our more privileged ones. Bigotry in all forms, including, but not limited to: Nazis, white supremacist, homophobes, transphobes, TERFs (trans exclusionary radical feminist), etc are **Not Welcome** at LARP COR Fireside Chat events and will be ejected without appeal. Do not wear any symbols associated with these paradigms, have them visible in the background of your video call, or use them in your avatar picture or nickname.
