



FAQ for Transportation to Norfolk Aggie

My child is in-county and wants to take the bus. Is there a schedule for the buses?

Yes! Take a look at our [In-county Bus Schedule](#). You will see the bus schedule for our in-county students.

Do I need to register for the in-county bus?

No registration needed! Just look at the schedule and be at the stop 10 minutes before the scheduled time. Also, **please wait outside your vehicle** so the driver can see that there are passengers waiting to be picked up.

My child is out-of-county. How do they get to school?

Please contact the transportation department in the town in which you reside. They will provide you with information for how they plan on transporting your child to school. Norfolk Aggie does not have the information from each of the out-of-county schools so please contact them. Also, you are always welcome to drive your student as well.

What if my child is out of county but wants to take an in-county bus? Can they do that?

This is only allowed if space is available. First priority is our in-county students. Out of county students should be traveling via their home districts' transportation. Please contact the Main Office to see if space is available. If space is available, please be sure that the student connects with the driver when they board the bus to let them know what stop they will exit at.

I'm dismissing my child early from school. Where do I park?

Prior to 1:30 p.m., you may park in front of McFarland Hall. If you are arriving after 1:30 p.m., please **park behind the Old Admin building** so you are not interfering with bus traffic.

We live in Boston. How do we get a Charlie Card bus pass?

Boston supplies its students with Charlie Cards for transportation. The Main Office receives cards for those Boston students during the first few weeks of school. Your child will receive an email from the Main Office when they receive it. .

Once those students have their Charlie Card, what is the best MBTA route/line for my student to get to the Aggie?

It depends on where you live in Boston but our A2 bus makes stops in Brookline and West Roxbury. Please see our in-county list above. Also, you may want to check the schedules for the [MBTA](#) to see what would be the best connecting route/stop.
