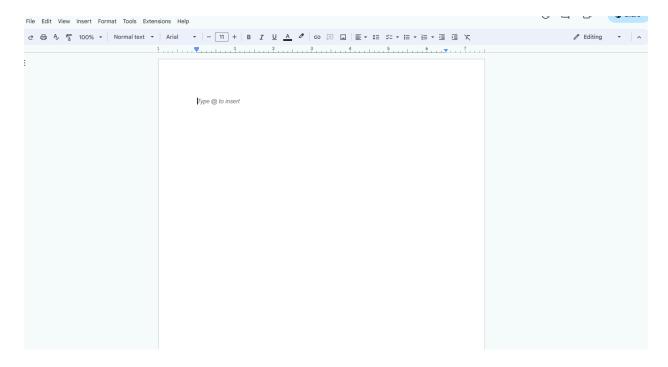

Here's our step-by-step guide on how to insert a border in google docs.

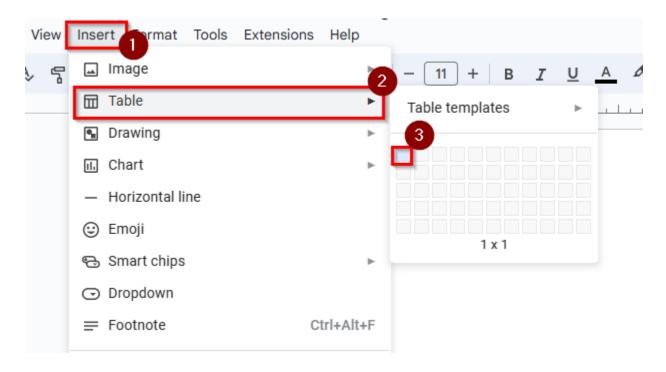
Step 1

First, open the document that requires a border.



Step 2

Click on Insert > Table and create a new 1x1 table.



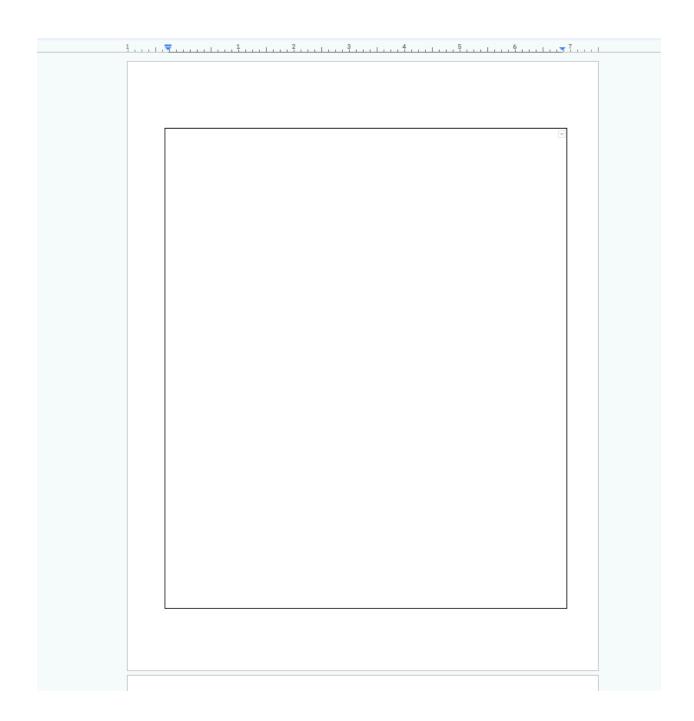
Step 3

The 1x1 table should now appear in your document.



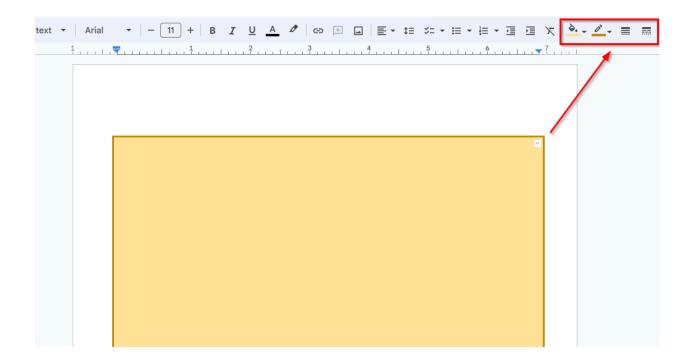
Step 4

Use your cursor to drag the bottom of the 1x1 cell downward. Keep dragging until the 1x1 cell fills the entire document.



Step 5

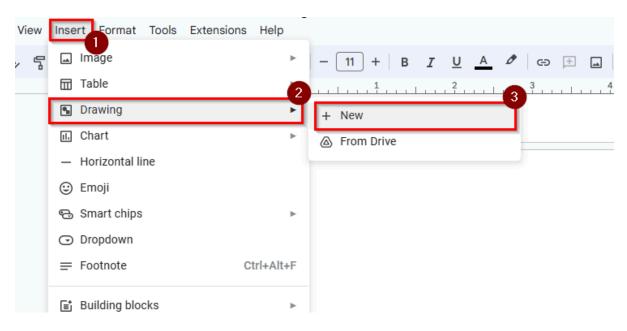
We can use various formatting options on the 1x1 cell. For example, we can change the border color, border thickness, and even the background color of the cell.



Step 6

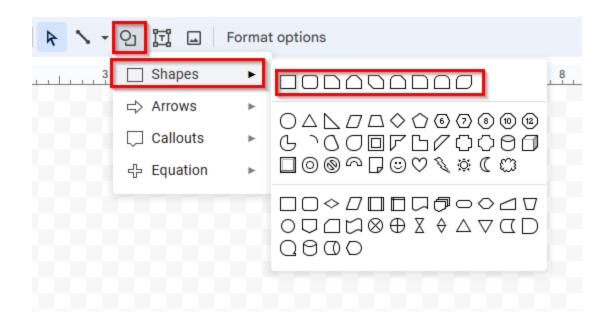
Another way to add a border is through the Drawing tool.

To add a new drawing, click on Insert > Drawing > New.



Step 7

In the Shapes icon, select any rectangular shape to add it to the checkered canvas.



Step 8

We can add our desired text to our rectangular shape and insert it into our document.

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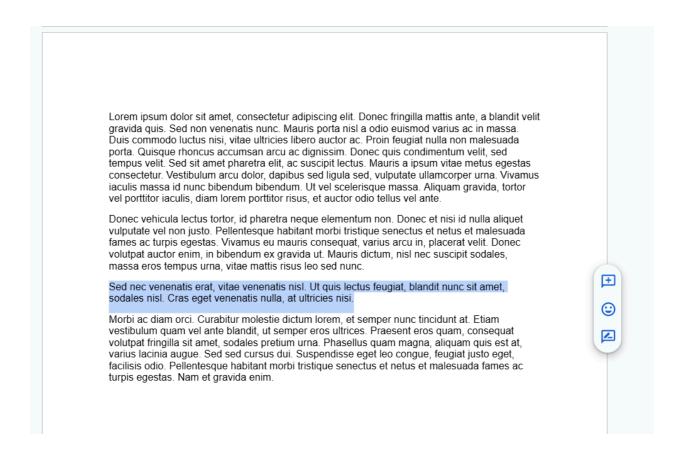
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Step 9

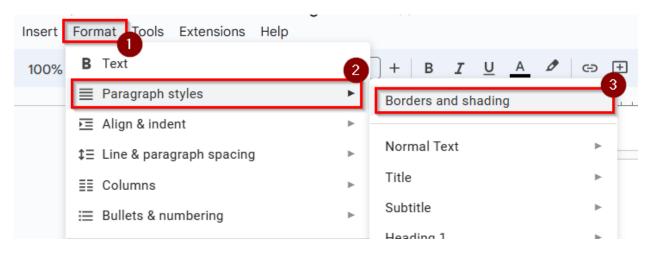
Besides adding a border around a page, we can also add a border around a specific paragraph as well.

First, select the paragraph you want to add a border to.



Step 10

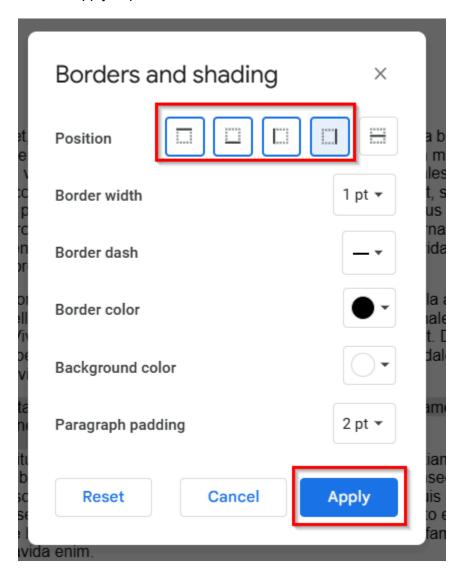
Click on Format > Paragraph styles > Borders and shading.



Step 11

In the Position section, check the first four boxes to add a border to the top, bottom, left, and right side of the paragraph.

Click on Apply to proceed.



Step 12

The selected paragraph should now have a border around it.

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The user can also change the border's color, background color, and style.
