Feed the Frog

The Type

Feed the Frog is an outdoor team-based game that requires players to launch rubber insects into the mouth of a frog that rotates around and opens and closes sporadically.

Description/Source

Fountain in Washington Square Park is transformed to a life-sized version of the [nostalgic game Mr. Mouth](#), where 4 players compete to launch rubber frogs into a moving mouth a frog in the middle of the fountain.

To make the competition more exciting, we can have 5 catapults — one to represent each borough of New York City.

The Space

The game will take place in the central fountain that is currently empty in the winter. At the center of the fountain is a water spout, which will serve as the focal point of the game.

Goal

To successfully feed the rotating frog with as many bugs as you can using the catapult provided- all within 60 seconds.

Rules

There will be 4 teams of 1-3 players based at the outer ring of the fountain. Each team is given a large catapult and will have a set of foam insect boards that are colored in their specific team color.

At the center of the fountain is a frog mouth that will rotate around and close and open.

The goal of the game is to be the team that can get as many of their foam insect bugs into the frog's mouth in 30 seconds or a minute.
