

2025 Catholic Education Foundation Student Art Contest Criteria

Materials:

- All students in grades K-8 attending a Catholic elementary school in the Archdiocese of Louisville are invited to produce a drawing or painting for their division using acrylics, crayons, felt markers, inks, pastels or watercolors.
- No collage materials (including glitter and feathers) are allowed.
- No 3D images.
- All work must be submitted on 12x18 paper or white card stock.

Criteria:

The subject for this year's contest is: Listen. Teach. Send. Fostering a Faithful Community. We are examples of Jesus when we listen and care for those in our school community. How do I model Jesus' teachings in my community?

- One entry per school for each division: K-2nd grade; 3rd-5th grade and 6th-8th grade.
- The work must be the original work of the student and may be done at school under the supervision of a teacher or at home
- All artwork must be submitted through the art teacher or another appropriate staff person at the school.
- All entries must be current.
- Students must not sign their work.
- Do not submit framed, matted, or mounted artwork.

Submission

• Submit your entry to Mrs. Bradshaw by Monday, December 16.

Criteria for judging

- Adherence to the theme
- Original interpretation of theme
- Evidence of skill commensurate with the age of the artist
- Composition

Prize

• Each winner will receive a \$250 cash prize and a framed copy of their winning artwork.
