PENCILS

1. Two sets of [Staedtler Mars Lumograph Drawing and Sketching Pencils - Set of 6](#)

CHALK

1. Three [Stabilo Carbothello Pastel Pencil Ivory \(#105\)](#)**note there may be issues with this not being in stock. if you're unable to purchase that is fine
2. Three [Stabilo Carbothello Pastel Pencil Titanium White \(#100\)](#)
3. Three [Conté à Paris Sketching Pencil White \(#630\)](#)
4. Three [General's White Charcoal Pencil \(#558\)](#)

PAPER

1. One [Canson Mi Teintes Drawing Papers 12"x16" Gray Tone Pad](#)

MISC

These can be purchased either from art stores or hardware stores. I noted in parentheses when better to purchase at hardware store

1. Masking or Painter's Tape (hardware store)
2. [Drawing Board or firm surface](#)
3. [Sanding block\(s\)](#) - much easier to sand to a finer point with a sanding block but a hard table can work as well (hardware store)
4. Sand paper - 220 grit **AND** 150 grit (hardware store)
5. [Snap off utility knife](#) - many different options, can get from art store or hardware store
6. Wooden skewer or knitting needle for measuring
7. [Prismacolor kneaded eraser](#)
8. Blending stumps and tortillons - no specific brands or types, just a few different ones so you can have separate ones for chalk and graphite
