

Lacy Tie crochet pattern (@queercusrobur):

It took me 2 hours (and I'm not known for my speed).

Row 1: ch 75 (tie body) + however much you need to go around your neck and have a bit more (for the knot), I did 110 st;

Row 2: (obv turn your work), hdc until you reach the original 75th chain, FROM THERE: ch 2, skip 2 stiches and form the third dc 13 (5 times);

Row 3: dc 4, ch 2, skip 2 st, treble crochet 1, ch 2, skip 2 st, dc 4, ch 2, skip 2 st (5 times), then hdc until the end of the row;

Row 4: hdc until the 75th st; ch 2, dc 2, ch 3, sl st in the 2 ch space, sl st on the tr, sl st in the next 2 ch space, ch 3, skip 2 st, dc 2, ch 2 (5 times);

Row 5: dc 4, ch 2, tr 1 (on the central sl st), ch 2, dc 4, ch 2 (5 times); hdc until the end of the row.

Row 6: hdc until the 75th st; ch 2, dc 13, ch 2 (5 times). Do **not** fasten off.

Pointy thing: Turn your work and hdc on the short side (I did 12 st), on the second row repeat, from the third hdc2tog 1 at the beginning and 1 at the end until it is as pointy or as round as you like. Fasten off.



Border: (from the chain before the 75th) attach the yarn, ch 4, skip 3 st, hdc 1 in the fourth st (all around until you reach the other side). Fasten off.
