Sponsorships

Sponsorship of the event comes with some requirements we have to check it is ok:

It was clarified that these sponsors have been organizations who have agreed to cover the costs of rooms, basic catering, etc that was offered to host the FIWARE Summit in Utrecht.

Ulrich: who are the sponsors? Arjan/Tom: list not finally closed. There will be a meeting tomorrow.

Ulrich: how much time should we book for the Major? Arjan/Tom: we will come with a response after the meeting tomorrow.

AP on Arjan/Tom to come with response to these question after the meeting tomorrow.

Ulrich: we have invited Mario Campolargo from the EC (Deputy DG DIGIT) and Willen Jonker (EIT Digital) and both have accepted.

Ulrich: do we know what would be the keynote from KPN be about?

Ulrich clarifies that plenary sessions will take place during the second day from 09:00am to 11:00am and during the third day, from 11:30am to 13:30pm.

H2020: C2NET or CREMA or PSYMBIOSYS or BEinCPPS - "Connected Factories" FAR EDGE and AUTOWARE in Factory Automation, vfOS and NIMBLE in Collaborative Manufacturing and Logistics). Experiences coming from these projects may be brought for designing the agenda of this track.

EIT Digital High Impact Initiative OEDIPUS in digital industry is coordinated by SIEMENS (Reiner Ufrecht) and one of its tasks, led by Engineering and with CR FIAT as use case, is devoted to "Plant condition monitoring" using the FIWAREforIndustry Industrial IOT platform. This is also a good candidate.
