## **BEFORE THE SUMMIT**

### **About Obonjan Island**

Obonjan island is centrally located within Croatia's Adriatic coastline, next to the town of Šibenik. Learn more about the island and experience at the [Obonjan website](#).

### **How to get to Obonjan?**

Zadar and Split airports are the closest, with an onward journey time of only 45-60 minutes to the Port of Šibenik. Read more about transport to and from the island; including info on closest airports, bus options and boat schedule at [Transportation Info](#).

### **What is included in the ticket price?**

Your ticket includes accommodation of your choice at the time of purchase for 5 days/4 nights and all meals during the Summit, including breakfast, lunch and dinner each day. All meals will be made with locally sourced ingredients and a high environmentally sustainable philosophy. Alcoholic drinks are not included in the ticket price. Bars are open whenever we have an event in a particular place of the island (eg amphitheatre bar open when we're having a gathering there).

### **Food & drink places on the island**

All meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner) will be served at the Pool Restaurant. However, there are also alternative cafes and restaurants where you can purchase food out of these times. Please be discreet about bringing any external consumables to Obonjan - the island will provide!

### **Who is organising the Summit?**

The "[Global Summit Committee](#)" is made of the same team that organised the Panamá Summit - Jonah Brotman, Tia Kansara, Charles Michel - together with members that raised their hand in 2016: Will Curran, Brandon Kaufer, Asia Lindsay, Lucija Matic, Ines Santos Silva, Charlotte Terrien and Franco Amorosi. The team has a strong expertise in hospitality, event production, hosting, communications and community building.



## Who is documenting the Summit?

The media content creation team is led by Alicia Sully and Sebastian Lindstrom, same as the 2012 Lisbon Summit, supported by community volunteers such as [Karim Iliya](#) and professional guests dedicated to photography and video including guest filmmaker [Lina Plioplyte](#). Outputs will include a 2 min video "What is Sandbox?", a "Confessional Booth" short-video installation, and a documentary.

## Boat Transfers

**Group boat transfers** will be arranged for **Monday, May 29th** and **Friday, June 2nd**. We need a minimum of 35 people for the boat to leave the port, and maximum of 60 people with luggage per boat. We kindly ask you for your coordination here - please arrive to the port as early as you can and take the first next boat out, so we make sure everyone gets transferred on time. For the guests who booked an extra night (leaving on **Saturday, June 3rd**) we have arranged one boat leaving at 12:00pm (noon).

**Strongly recommended:** if your flight from Zadar or Split is scheduled for any time earlier than 12:00pm (noon) on Fri, Jun 2nd, we recommend to leave the island before the first scheduled boat.

## Arriving early / late or departing early?

If you're arriving at the island at any other time than scheduled (Monday, May 29th) please **contact taxi boat coordinators** Rok Zajc ([rok.zajc@cmt.si](mailto:rok.zajc@cmt.si)) or Miro Petrina ([miro\\_petrina@yahoo.com](mailto:miro_petrina@yahoo.com), +385 95 504 8037) directly. Same for early departures (before Friday, June 2nd). Always ask or inform for how many people so the cost can be optimized by delivering right boat size. Payments on the spot directly to taxi boat driver.

*Informative price from one of many taxi boat supplier - for 1 taxi boat up to 6 pax: 500 kn for 2 pax + 50 kn each additional pax + 200 kn for night ride (for example, for 5 pax the full price is 650 kn for daily transfer one way + supplement of 200 kn in case of night transfer)*

## What to bring with you?

### ESSENTIALS

- Valid Passport (double check for visa requirements) - Please have this on yourself when arriving to the boat - **DO NOT LEAVE IT IN YOUR BAG.**
- Summit Ticket confirmation (on your phone ideally, avoid printing)
- Comfortable everyday clothes (t-shirts/ tanks, shorts, lightweight pants, light long sleeves, dresses, swimsuit, hat, you know... island clothes). The weather should be wonderful but it might get chilly at night if the wind comes up, so be prepared (rain mac or light rain jacket recommended!)
- Appropriate shoes: all roads on the island are gravelled and sometimes rocks are pretty sharp.
- Toiletries: Hand soap and toilet paper are included. Bring your own shampoo and toothpaste.
- Refillable water bottle and/or drinking cup. We suggested Obonjan to have a no-plastic policy on the island, so carry your cup!
- The theme of the Dance Party on Wednesday night is going to be "Future-Self", so bring the best outfit you ever imagine to be wearing!
- A white t-shirt you will be able to customize.
- A notebook and a pen.

### RECOMMENDED

- Elegant outfits for our opening/closing ceremony.
- Water shoes recommended for swimming!
- Beach towel - Obonjan provides bath towels but we recommend to bring your own for the beach
- Head light/lamp/flashlight.
- Power converter to European plug.
- Day pack/light shoulder bag (for carrying books/pens or small items).
- Bring a book that you've loved reading to exchange with others. We'll have a designated library. In the first page, please write a note to the mystery person who may pick up your book!
- Luggage lock. There are security boxes at reception, and in Forest Lodges accommodation. Every tent/lodge has a door lock.
- Dry bag (for valuables).
- HRK (Croatian cash) however there will be an ATM on the Island (but don't rely on it).
- Earplugs, and eye mask for comfort sleeping!
- Your favourite color post-it pad

## What you don't need to bring

- Alcohol - we will have bars where you can purchase drinks!
- Obonjan provides bedding, linens and towels (no beach towels though).
- Hair dryer.



## **DURING THE SUMMIT**

### **Reception**

During the summit, the team will be available for anything you need, please contact +385 95 7332 213 for the help line reception. The reception is opened 24 hours, 7 days per week. Local tourist information is also available at reception.

### **Reporting Issues**

If you have any issues with Obonjan, please report it to us or at the reception. There will be a book where you can report and sign any issues that might occur. This will help us fix it with the Obonjan team promptly. Also we are under contract that anything reported directly to the register will still be included in their hospitality insurance.

### **Payments**

Additional purchases on the island can be made through cash and / or credit card (convenience store, merchandise, restaurants etc). Credit cards that are accepted are Amex, Diners, Mastercard, Visa and cash in Euros and Kuna.

### **Security and Valuables**

For guests staying in bell tents, we recommend storing valuable items in the safety deposit boxes located within the reception building which can be rented for a small charge. Safes are available in each Forest Lodge.

### **Medical Treatment**

Medical treatment is available at the medical centre located behind Bok restaurant. If you require medical treatment during your stay, please visit the medical centre or tell a member of our team immediately. However, this is a third party medical service so they charge per call out. We suggest you bring a small First Aid kit just in case and strongly recommend to buy a travel insurance before your trip.

### **Taxi Boats**

Taxi boats operate throughout the day and night (24/7) at the Island. The taxi boats are operated by third party providers and the use of them is at your own risk. Sandbox and Obonjan have no liability to you should you choose to use a taxi boat. For all private boat arrangements (if you're arriving or departing outside the scheduled boat times) please contact taxi boat coordinators Rok Zajc ([rok.zajc@cmt.si](mailto:rok.zajc@cmt.si)) or Miro Petrina ([miro\\_petrina@yahoo.com](mailto:miro_petrina@yahoo.com)) directly or ask for help at the reception.
