

Lander's River Trips – Campground Rules and Regulations

The following rules are in effect to help you enjoy a safe and happy visit at our campground.

- ❖ Check-out time is 11AM.
 - ❖ Quiet hours are from 11PM to 7AM. Please be considerate of others during this time. Security guards are on duty Friday and Saturday night to help enforce these quiet hours. Excessive noise or rowdiness will result in a minimum fine of \$200 (to be charged to the credit card on file) as well as eviction without refund.
 - ❖ Any property damage will be assessed and charged to the group leader. This includes (but is not limited to) cutting of trees or shrubs, defacing the lawn/landscaping, damaging picnic tables, or damaging/defacing bathhouses in any way. Each of these offenses results in a minimum of a \$100 fine charged to the credit card on file.
 - ❖ In New York State it is **illegal** and punishable by law to discharge firearms or fireworks. Therefore, it is strictly prohibited in the campground.
 - ❖ Trash cans are provided for your use. Please keep your site clean to help us maintain our environment. A minimum fee of \$50 will be charged to the credit card on file if sites are not left as they were found.
 - ❖ Pets must be kept on a leash at all times, and must be cleaned up after. Noisy pets are not welcome.
 - ❖ Movement from one site to another is prohibited unless permission is obtained from the office in advance.
 - ❖ Parents are responsible for the actions and safety of their children.
 - ❖ Swimming pools are prohibited on the campground.
 - ❖ Speed on all campground roads is restricted to 10 mph. Driving on grass or through sites is strictly prohibited.
 - ❖ There is a limit of 2 cars per site. Please display your car pass in your front windshield if issued one from the office. Any additional vehicles may be parked in the parking area outside the campground gates. If your vehicle is inside the campground gate and does not have a car pass, your vehicle will be towed at your expense.
 - ❖ Please leave bathrooms and showers as you would like to find them. Please report any maintenance problems to the office.
 - ❖ ATV's are prohibited in the campground.
