Whether you come from theatre, dance, writing, visual art, or another creative discipline, your perspective is valued.

The workshop will include:

- Physical devising and improvisation
- Writing exercises and personal storytelling
- Creative collaging with imagery and objects
- Space to reflect, share, and play

Come experiment, collaborate, and help shape a work that embraces the messiness, beauty, and contradictions of modern parenthood.
