These are the rules each team must follow to be part of the SP LMP1 championship.

•The Team

°A Team should include Driver, Engineer, Manager and optionally a co-driver. A team should be made up of at least 3 people and a max of 8.

°We recommend all of the team uses discord and creates a team discord channel. We also recommend joining the official SP LMP1 championship discord server [Here](#).

•Vehicles.

°A team must have a vehicle to take part in the race. They also may have a transportation truck and camper but that is optional.

°When constructing the vehicle you must follow the technical details which you can read [Here](#).

•Taking part

°To compete your team will need to be signed up.

°You can sign you team up for the championship [Here](#).

°To take part you will also need a driver. To become a driver for SP LMP1 you will need your SP LMP1 drivers licence. You can obtain your SP LMP1 drivers licence [Here](#).

•Raceday

°The driver taking part in the race will need to be able to screen record his/her device at 30fps or better.

You will need to share your screen recording to an organiser. You will be timed.

- ENTRIES
 - Entry video for gold prix qualifier must be submitted by 11:59pm United States Central Standard Time on June 15th, 2018. Video must be unedited from start to finish, at 30fps or better. Gold prix qualifier is 5 laps, the 5 teams with the fastest combined lap times will move on to Le Mans qualifying
- QUALIFYING AT LE MANS
 - To qualify for Le Mans you must be in the top 5 fastest times between all the teams at Gold Prix
 - The 5 teams will record a start to finish video of 4 laps at Le Mans. If the car runs out of gas before you cross the finish line at the end of the 4th lap, you are disqualified. No gliding across the finish line.
 - The 2 slowest teams will be eliminated. Entries must be submitted by June 24th at 11:59pm CST 2018
- LE MANS FINALS
 - The top 3 teams will now progress to the final endurance race.
 - Each team must record a start to finish video of TWENTY (20) laps of Le Mans, without running out of fuel. This race showcases concentration and endurance of the vehicles your teams have created. Video due June 27th 2018 at 11:59pm.
 - The slowest team will be eliminated
- LE MANS FINAL RACE
 - The two remaining teams will run a time trial of Le Mans for 10 laps. The fastest time will win. Video due June 30th 2018 at 11:59pm.
