#### When is the best time of year to elope in Tillamook?

May through September has the warmest weather in Oregon with the least chance of rain.

#### Do you need an officiant to get married in Oregon?

Yes. You will need a licensed officiant.

#### How much does an Oregon marriage license cost?

A marriage license cost \$60.

# Best Time of Year to Get Married/Elope in Tillamook

### **Tillamook Seasons & Weather**

## Winter: (December-February)

The average temperature for the winter in Tillamook is 53 degrees. Winter is less busy which would allow for you and your partner to escape the crowds. Winter also has the most rain, but if you're down to run around in the rain, so am I.

## **Spring:**(March-May)

The average temperature for spring is 58 degrees. The spring is still pretty rainy so it's the perfect time to see waterfalls. May is the perfect spring month to elope because of all the blooming flowers and green forests.

## Summer: (June-August)

Summer in Tillamook has the perfect weather with the temperature never getting above 69 degrees. Tillamook summers also have less rain and allow for so many fun elopement day activities like kayaking, swimming by waterfalls, and jumping in the ocean after your ceremony.

### **Fall:** Winter (September-November)

The fall in Tillamook has all the gorgeous fall colors and fog for epic elopement day backdrops. The weather is mild with averages in the 40s. The fall is when the rain starts to become more consistent so be prepared with some rain gear for your elopement.

# **Cape Lookout State Park**

<u>Cape lookout</u> is perfect if you and your partner are looking for a stunning beach location. Cape Lookout has the rocky cliffs, sandy beach, and green fields and forests. Cape lookout also has some sick yurts and cabins nearby to stay at.

#### **Munson Creek Falls**

<u>Munson Creek Falls</u> is a waterfall just outside of Tillamook. The trail is a quarter of a mile to the falls so it's easy and very accessible. The falls would be a perfect elopement location if you're looking for tall trees, greenery, and, of course, the waterfall.

# **Bayocean Peninsula**

<u>Bayocean</u> has endless ocean views, grassy fields, trails, and a beach with dunes. Bayocean is also less busy which is perfect for an intimate elopement.

### **Cape Meares Viewpoint**

<u>Cape Meares</u> has rocky cliffs on the beach with unique trees and its famous <u>lighthouse</u>. The views of the ocean and cliffs are insane from Cape Meares and it would make a perfect elopement location.

#### **Oregon Marriage Laws:**

- Must be at least 18 years old
- 3 day waiting period
- Cannot be currently married

- Apply for your license. You can do this online or in person.
- Pay your license fee
- Wait to receive your license
