



Southampton High School's National Art Honor Society Chapter By-laws

1. **Member Selection-** Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors who have taken Art Classes each year they are in high school may apply to our Chapter. They must meet the criteria under sections 2, 3, and 4 of these bylaws.
2. **Character-** Students must continue to demonstrate service, leadership, and cooperation.
3. **Grades-** Members must maintain a 90 or better average in their Art classes and an average of 85 or better overall. Grades will be checked each quarter.
4. **Art Classes-** Students must be in an Art class each school year they are a member.
5. **Dues-** Annual dues to NAHS will be paid for by Southampton High School. There is no student charge for membership.
6. **Attendance-** Attendance is required at monthly meetings (10 meetings). Additional meetings will be scheduled around major projects.
7. **Service Hours-** All members must volunteer in at least 10 hours of their time to work on projects, activities, and fundraisers. Meeting hours that are for project work may count toward volunteering hours. Mrs. Collins will keep track of each member's volunteering hours in a log book.
8. **Officers-** Officers must attend all meetings. New officers will be nominated and elected at the end of each school year for the new school year. Due to the small size of our Chapter, any empty position's responsibilities will be managed by the current officers until the position is filled.
9. **Good Standing-** To graduate with NAHS honors and earn the right to wear a cord at graduation, a member must remain in good standing according to these bylaws until the date of graduation.
10. **Infraction-** In the event of an infraction of rules, a review by the Chapter sponsor will be conducted.
