What to Expect:

Special Assignment:

To ensure you're ready for the challenges ahead and to gauge your current proficiency, please complete the following assignments before August 23rd:

Assignment #1: "El Viaje de mis Sueños" (DUE THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL)

1. **Write a Short Paragraph:** Write a short paragraph in Spanish (minimum 150 words) describing your dream trip to a Spanish-speaking country. Include details about the destination, activities you would do, and why you chose this place. **Do not copy, use AI or translators.** This assignment won't be graded as it will be a way for you to show me your current skills in the language.
2. **Include Vocabulary and Grammar:** Demonstrate your use of advanced vocabulary and grammatical structures you have learned in previous courses. Be creative and descriptive!
3. **Submit Your Work:** Your paragraph will be handwritten and submitted on the first day of class (August 14th) I will review it to help tailor the course to your needs.

This assignment will help you review key concepts and allow me to better understand your current level.

The following assignments will be due no later than AUGUST 22nd:

All writing assignments will be submitted handwritten, typed work will not be accepted

You will complete the 4 assignments below. Time management and self- motivation are essential for success in this course. Commit to complete one assignment a day between now and the start of the year.

Note: You are expected to do your own work and not use any online translators. Your goal is not to worry about being perfect in Spanish at this time, but to improve your comprehension and writing. (I do want you to work on correcting your own mistakes.) You may use an online dictionary such as wordreference.com to look up vocabulary and conjugations but not to translate full sentences.

Assignment # 2:

News, radio, and listening activities. Read and listen to 3 Spanish language news articles/broadcasts/podcasts. Please complete the following activities for each selection:

1. Write a list of vocabulary words in Spanish (approximately 5-10 words)
2. Write a brief summary in Spanish of the article/broadcast/podcast (5-6 sentences)
3. Please include:
 - Website/link for broadcast
 - Title of article/broadcast/podcast

Assignment #4:

The movie should not be dubbed/translated. You may watch episodes from a Spanish language series in place of a movie.

Get creative: read, write, speak and sing in Spanish every time you get a chance. Watch television in Spanish, Spanish language commercials, and Spanish language movie trailers. Write emails and text messages in Spanish.
