

Virtual Games

- Pictionary Game:
 - <https://skribbl.io/>
 - An online game that PF's can easily control with such things as time, player access and words used in the game.
 - Can be used for vocabulary list words and is a great game to bond
- Another Pictionary Variety
 - Use a random generator, something like <https://randomwordgenerator.com/pictionary.php>
 - Have one person draw in the google meet jamboard and everyone else guess
 - You could have them guess in teams for points
- Kahoot

 - You can create your own or use a premade quiz or trivia.
 - Good for connecting or studying if you have content for a group (be careful there is a tendency for students to use inappropriate names)
- Blooket

 - Very similar to Kahoot
- Bingo

 - Create your own bingo cards.
 - You could use it for things like vocabulary. Instead of reading off the word, give the definition and see if they have the corresponding word?
- Scattergories

 - This site randomizes a letter with a series of different categories. Start the timer and come up with one word answers for each category starting with the random letter
- Random Trivia Generator

 - Trivia site that hosts a flipcard style random queue of trivia questions. Questions can be sorted by category or a random mix. Click a card to flip it and see the answer.
 - Use an external timer to amp up the pressure (but also keep the game moving)
- Mafia on Zoom and Google Meet

 - The game continues by alternating between night and day. By night, the Mafia will kill a person, and in the day, the civilians choose to eliminate one player.
 - Game goes until all players on one side are eliminated.

 - Lots of different interactive activities that are easy to use and interact with.
 - Great for educational content or even just a fun game time
- **A Fake Artist Goes to New York**

- **Broken Picture Phone**
 - Each player starts by creating a phrase, which is then passed along to another member of the party who then draws that phrase. It's then passed to the next player who tries to determine a phrase from the image. This pattern, switching between drawing and phrases, until it's back to the beginning. Everyone goes back and reveals the drawings and phrases to the group

- **What do you meme**
 - Someone puts a bunch of memes on a google slides and presents their screen
 - Everyone types in a caption and everyone votes on whose they think is the funniest
- **Codenames**
 - This game is played by one player giving one word clues to the rest of their team who then have to guess which word based off the clue

- **Free Virtual Online Whiteboard**

 - Can be used to help with school work or even for a fun game of virtual Hangman or other quick activities.
- **Scavenger Hunt**
 - Leader calls out/ posts an item/list of items for students to find
 - Most found/fastest finder wins
- **Speed Greeting**
 - Think speed dating but without the awkward romance
 - Requires ability to create break out rooms
 - Set up several rounds of break out rooms ahead of time, or in the beginning while activity is being explained
 - Everyone gets 1 minute to meet each other
- ***Optional Additions***
 - Have everyone pick one question to ask everyone they talk to
 - This can be shared at the end, something like having one person introduce themselves at a time and then everyone else share what they learned about that person
 - Have a set of questions for everyone to draw from
- **Meme Contest**
 - Have everyone submit a meme that describes how they feel about x thing
 - Everyone votes on what's best
 - Have several rounds and crown a winner
- **Family Feud**
