<p>Instructor: Mustafa Polat</p>	<p>Time: 40 minutes Unit: 4 Nature and Animals</p>
<p>Analyse learners</p>	<p>Learner Characteristics: High School preparatory students, ages 14-15, Turkish Students, intermediate English Proficiency</p> <p>Entry Competencies: Students are aware of some words can have several meanings/different usages and they can form basic sentences.</p> <p>Learning Styles: Mix of kinaesthetic and visual learners, they have preferences for interactive activities</p>
<p>State objectives</p>	<p>After listening/reading instructions about incoming activities, preparatory students will be able to search concordances of given words (See, look, watch). By these practices, they will reinforce their prior knowledge of polysemes.</p>
<p>Select instructional methods, media, and materials</p>	<p>Instructional Strategies: Direct method</p> <p>Technology: CorpusMate</p> <p>Media: Digital worksheets</p> <p>Materials: Computers/tablets, internet access, projector</p>
<p>Utilize media and materials</p>	<p>Preview the Technology: Test the CorpusMate website</p> <p>Prepare the Materials: Load and prepare digital worksheets.</p> <p>Prepare the Environment: Arrange desks for the lesson and ensure all devices are charged.</p> <p>Provide the Learning Experience: Start with an Instructions of incoming activities. Wrap up with a fill in the blank activity followed by a individual searching activity using CorpusMate. Afterwards, production and comprehension activities.</p>

<p>Require learner participation</p>	<p>Engagement: Finding the different examples of the chosen words via CorpusMate. Interactive discussions through the end of the lesson on the polysemes that they have found and wrote.</p> <p>Practice: Students complete exercises on the worksheets and create sentences using the polysemes of the words.</p>
<p>Evaluate and revise</p>	<p>Assessment of Learner Achievement: Evaluating students' performances in their worksheets. Assessing their understanding on the concept and polysemes.</p> <p>Evaluation of Strategies & Technology: Reflect on students' engagement with CorpusMate and use of Computers.</p> <p>Revisions: Consider providing more guided practice or adjusting the difficulty level of digital worksheets based on student performance.</p>
