In the meantime, a number of backup and downtime procedures have been implemented, enabling our staff to provide safe, comprehensive inpatient and outpatient care to hundreds of patients since June 1.

Cybersecurity events like these take time to fully resolve. Significant progress is being made on that front. We remain committed to delivering on our promise to the community to meet their health care needs and will resume normal operations as quickly as possible.
