

GRASSY GROVE CENTER POP-OUT CARD

Inspired by Gillian stamps and presented by Barbz Bicknell (Barbara.b@outlook.co.nz)

Supplies:

Stamps: Grassy Grove

Paper: Pretty Peacock, Basic White, Basic Black, Lost Lagoon cardstock, One Horse Open Sleigh DSP 162118

Ink: Pretty Peacock, Lost Lagoon

Other: Grove Dies, Linen Thread

Measurements:

Pretty Peacock 11 ¼" x 4"cm, scored at 5 -1/8"

Basic White Cardstock 11"x 3 ¾" scored at 2.75", 5.5" & 8.25"

One Horse Open Sleigh Designer Series Paper 3.75" x 5.5"



Instructions:

1. Mark on the die the centre and line it up with the centre scoreline so it's perfectly centred. Die cut out the scene.
2. Place post it notes on each side, so it lines up with the 2.75" and 8.25" scores to prevent ink staining on the outer panels.
3. Stamp the 3-tree stamp with Pretty Peacock ink and without inking the trunks stamp twice all over without inking again for the 2nd impression (this is referred to as 2nd generation stamping. It gives a nice variance of colour to the trees and the ground and down the sides. If necessary, sponge Pretty Peacock ink along the sides to prevent a white gap between the stamping and the outer scores.
4. Remove the post it notes and stamp your choice of sentiment on the left panel and the trees on the right panel using Pretty Peacock ink.
5. Cut 2 deer in black cardstock with the dies and attach the mother deer to the right fixing her to the tree trunks and baby deer to the left fixed to the ground.
6. Fold the designer paper in half and bond it well to the centre of the card making sure it is tight into the fold and the card folds well. Use your bone folder to spread the glue well and activate the bond.
7. Attach the left inside panel lining up between the card edge giving an even clearance and the centre fold. Open and check the spacing. Glue the right panel, attaching to the right hand inside of the card base and make sure it is opening properly if you use tombo multipurpose glue it gives you time to reposition if needed.

8. Stamp the two trees in the centre of the Lost Lagoon card with Pretty Peacock ink and cut out



with the dies. Sponge the edges if you wish. Make loops of the linen thread and attach to the back of the trees. Set aside.

9. Stamp the foreground in Pretty Peacock, the two trees to the right, then stamp the 3 trees in the centre with Lost Lagoon. Attach the die cut with dimensionals.
10. Fix the white panel to the Lost Lagoon layer over the die cut hole and attach to the front of the card.

You have finished your beautiful card. Well done, hope you love it!
