Travel

- **Transport:** Travel will be by bus from the Church (26 Hi-Tech Drive, Toormina NSW 2452). If you need a lift from home to the bus stop at church, please **text Pastor Duffy 0401 027 694 by Sunday 10 May 2026** and be ready for **pick up between 4:30 - 4:45pm on Friday**.
- **Departure:** Bus leaves church at 5:00pm, so please **be at the Church by 4:45pm Friday**
- **Return:** We aim to arrive back at the church around 2:45 pm Sunday (traffic dependent). Parents/carers will be sent a text notification when we leave the camp. It's approx. 45min drive, please be ready to collect your children.

Meals

- Towel and Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothbrush and toothpaste)

- Torch (optional)
- Tent (if not staying in cabins)
