The London Borough of Hackney is applying to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for consent under Article 12 of the Greater London Parks and Open Spaces Order 1967 to carry out restricted works on London Fields.

The Planning Inspectorate will decide the application on behalf of the Secretary of State. The proposed works are:

- Ground level 38m² extension of existing park depot building, contained within the park's depot compound, to improve welfare facilities for the park's operations team.

The park depot is located next to London Fields Lido.
