The course Scientific Socialism is designed for undergraduate students in non-political theory majors and consists of eight chapters. The course equips learners with:

Knowledge:

Students understand the laws governing the emergence of the communist socio-economic formation, the conditions for the emergence and basic contents of scientific socialism, including the historical mission of the working class, socialism and the transition period to socialism, socialist democracy and the socialist state, class structure and class alliances in the transition period, and issues related to ethnicity, religion, and family during the transition to socialism.

Skills:

Students are able to explain social phenomena and processes based on the theoretical knowledge of scientific socialism.

Attitudes:

Students develop an optimistic attitude and confidence in the leadership of the Party, respect and comply with legal regulations in professional practice, and build a sense of responsibility in contributing to national development toward a socialist orientation.
