A. ONLINE ENCYCLOPEDIA

Example: Smith, P. (n.d.). Feminism. In *Encyclopædia Britannica*. <http://www.britannica.com/EBchecked/724633/feminism>

Author or editor (if given) (Last name, first initial). If no author listed, then put title before date.	(Date published). (n.d.) if no date	Title of article. (Capitalize first word and proper nouns only)	In Name of Encyclopedia. (Italics except for "In")	URL (no period at end of URL)

B. BOOKS

Example:

Calfee, R. C., & Valencia, R. R. (1991). *APA guide to preparing manuscripts*. American Psychological Association.

Author(s). (Last name, first initial).	(Year published).	Title of book. (In italics. Capitalize first word and proper nouns only)	Publisher.

C. IMAGE FROM THE INTERNET

Example:

Beaubien, S. (2017). A frozen world. *National Geographic YourShot*. <http://yourshot.nationalgeographic.com/photos/9704510/>

Artist(s). (Last name, first initial).	(Date published). (n.d.) if no date	Title of image. (Capitalize first word and proper nouns only)	Name of website. (in italics)	URL (no period at end of URL)

NOTE FOR ALL ELECTRONIC/ONLINE SOURCES: When possible, use (Year, Month Day) format. If the month and date are not available, use the year of publication.

D. ARTICLE FROM A DATABASE

Example: Smyth, A. M., Parker, A. L., & Pease, D. L. (2002). A study of enjoyment of peas. *Journal of Abnormal Eating*, 8(3), 120-125. <https://doi.org/10.102/mar.20105>

Author(s). (Last name, First initial).	(Date published). (n.d.). if no date	Title of article. (Capitalize first word and proper nouns only)	Journal Title, (in italics)	Volume(issue), Example: 8(3), (no space between)	Page #s.	URL or DOI *Use DOI over URL (no period at end of URL)

E. WEBSITE

Example: Smith, J. (2004, March 23). *A home fire escape plan can save your life*. American Red Cross.

Author or Editor - corporation or government may be author. (Last name, First initial.)	(Date published). (n.d.). if no date	Title of page used. (In italics. Capitalize first word and proper nouns only)	Title of website.	URL (no period at end of URL)

NOTE FOR ALL ELECTRONIC/ONLINE SOURCES: When possible, use (Year, Month Day). format. If the month and date are not available, use the year of publication.
