• <u>TL Issues</u>

- Textbooks:
 - We are working with Alex Orozco on addressing these issues. We are updating a letter from UTLA that we can share with principals regarding textbook issues.
 - Concerns regarding admin using the library for other things (storage, detention, testing during lunch, etc.)
 - A new job description will be coming to us shortly which will help address some of our job duty concerns.
 - John H. suggests making sure that TLs are tasked with keeping a neat, inviting library.
- Class coverages/subbing
 - Should be equitable and 1 period for day for extra pay. The expectation is that we have other duties and/or classes coming in during other periods.
- Lunch
 - Do we have to keep the library open during lunch? We do not need to keep it open for lunch. We can close it on occasion if we choose.
- Refresh
 - Money for books and materials must be encumbered by Dec. 15, but we can get paid for extra hours until June.

Area Meeting Updates

- Canvassing
