First Baptist Church is an independent church body located in Northeastern NY, built and established about 200 years ago. Our local body of born-again believers consists of married couples of various ages, several young families, as well as a few single adults. We also have a few members who spend the winter months in a warmer climate.

Our Sunday worship service is predominately traditional and averages 40 to 50 attendees with occasional visitors. There are two Sunday School classes for elementary children and a nursery during the morning service. Wednesday night prayer meetings have an attendance of 15 to 20.

While we are small in number, we have a wonderful spirit of love and unity as well as a desire to reach the unsaved locally and around the world. Through the years, God has used our church to send out many members into full-time ministry. We currently support 14 missionary families and are privileged to be the sending church for two young couples, one in home missions and one in foreign missions.

We are associated with the Northeast Fellowship of Independent Baptist Churches. Our pastors have been part of a local non-ecumenical Pastoral Fellowship. The Lord has graciously provided for all our needs, and for the past several decades we have been debt free.
