In many cases, people are matched with a provider within 48 hours, but this can vary depending on therapist availability.

After being matched, you can schedule your first session, choosing the format that feels most comfortable to you. Phone sessions, video sessions, and live chat sessions are available. You can also utilize the in-app messaging system to communicate with your therapist at any time, and they will typically respond as soon as possible.

Establishing a therapeutic connection with your therapist is crucial for effective treatment. That's why you're empowered to change BetterHelp providers at any time and for any reason, for no additional fees, until you find the right provider for your individual needs. If you decide to end your therapy subscription, you can cancel at any time.

- How do I know if therapy is right for me?

- Who are the BetterHelp therapists?

BetterHelp providers are part of a network of experienced therapists who must meet specific requirements in order to offer their services on the platform. Providers must be licensed to practice in their state as a marriage and family counselor, professional counselor, clinical social worker, or psychologist. Alternatively, they may hold a similar license based on their location.

Providers on the BetterHelp platform must also hold a relevant degree and have at least three years and 1,000 hours of clinical experience working with clients. Additionally, they must meet all licensing and qualification requirements in the state where they practice.

- Is online therapy more affordable than in-person therapy?

Online therapy and counseling services can be more affordable than in-person therapy. BetterHelp uses subscription pricing, which can be more affordable than paying for traditional in-person therapy services out of pocket. BetterHelp subscription costs range from \$70 to \$100 per week, billed either monthly or weekly. Please note that several factors, including location, referral source, preferences, applicable discounts, and therapist availability, determine the exact therapy cost. Discounts are only available to non-insured users.

- What can I expect at my first therapy session?

Starting something new can be challenging, and knowing what to expect can help alleviate some of the uncertainty before your first therapy session. Generally, you

and your therapist will use your first appointment to get to know each other and begin building a therapeutic relationship. Your therapist may work toward establishing a **supportive environment** where you can receive the assistance you need. They may ask you broad questions about your circumstances, like what brought you to therapy, or they may ask you to share a little bit about yourself.

During this initial session, your therapist may also share information about their experience and qualifications and discuss how the therapy process will unfold in subsequent sessions.
