Alongside the Receiving Manager, you will lead a team from the receiving of merchandise and inventory through the quality control and tagging process and ultimately creating beautifully branded merchandise that tells a story.

Job Responsibilities

- Works alongside the Receiving Manager to organize, process, streamline, and maintain cleanliness and safety in the warehouse space and company vehicles; including trash and cardboard removal.
- Ensures that all products have been checked for quality, enters correct inventory numbers into the company's e-commerce system, and appropriate price tags are created and printed to create a consistent, branded look amongst all stores.
- Curates and executes the presentation of the item with branded tagging. Creates and troubleshoots the creation of price tags that aesthetically fit the product.
- Receives supply lists from the Receiving Manager and creates packages of office, retail, and packaging supplies to be distributed to the stores.
- Informs Receiving Manager when supply stocks are low to be restocked through detailed lists.
- Communicates with customers regarding online orders, shipping information, updates regarding items, and any other inquiry into special orders.
- Packs and distributes items for in-store pickups and special orders after arrival in the warehouse. Works with the Receiving Manager to ensure prompt transfers.
- Communicates with store owners about distributing merchandise to the stores. Uses the e-commerce system to create transfers from warehouse stock to the stores.
- Packages all transferred products safely for transport to individual stores and arranges them for pick-up by drivers.
- In charge of all shipping for the online store and special orders. Pulls inventory and creates transfers when needed, packages items safely for transit, creates shipping labels, and arranges drop-offs and pick-ups to mail carriers.
- Keeps a detailed log of each order including when special orders were placed, shipping
 information from the vendor, and all customer correspondence and pertinent dates and
 information for special orders.
- Communicates with the store managers for special orders pertaining to their stores.
- Helps with annual inter-store inventory counts.

- Alongside the Receiving Manager, will occasionally lead and supervise teams of part-time employees through the processing and tagging systems during peak times.
- Occasionally travels to other stores to assist with restocking, deliveries, and sales.
