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Transportation Request Form

Mission Heights Preparatory High School provides bus transportation for students who live in Casa Grande, Arizona City, Eloy, and Toltec. We also provide transportation to and from CAVIT Session 1 (leaving MHP at 6:20am and returning to MHP at 9:30am) and Session 3 (leaving MHP at 12:00pm and returning to MHP at 3:00pm daily). *If your student is in CAVIT Session 1, we cannot bring them to school for the CAVIT bus.* Please read through all the information in the packet to understand what services we provide and on what conditions we provide them.

Obtaining transportation services from Mission Heights is a two-step process:

1. Review the MHP Bus Rules on the reverse side of this document and fill out the [Transportation Request Form](#) electronically.
2. Download and log in to the [Cariina-Parent app](#) on your smartphone.

Your student will not be allowed to ride the bus until both of these steps have been completed.

MHP Bus Rules

Make sure you are at your bus stop 10 minutes early. If the bus gets to your stop 10 minutes before the Stop time, it will leave.

ALL MHP SCHOOL RULES, POLICIES, & PROCEDURES APPLY WHILE RIDING THE BUS, including:

- Show your Student ID when getting on/off the bus
- Only get on/off the bus at your assigned stop (unless your parent has submitted a request on the Cariina Parent app).
- You must have a green “MHP P4 Bus Pass” to ride the P4 Bus.
- Respect the driver, other passengers, and their property.
- Follow all directions.
- Seats may be assigned by the bus driver.
- Keep all parts of the body inside the bus at all times.
- Keep all parts of the body out of the aisleways.
- Students should talk quietly and keep their hands to themselves.
- Absolutely NO FIGHTING.
- All students should be courteous to those around them. No profanity or obscene gestures.
- No eating, chewing gum, or drinking. (Except water)
- No littering or destruction of the bus.
- Keep your personal belongings under control at all times.
- Students are responsible for any damage they cause to the bus.
- Nothing is to be thrown outside of the bus.
- Students are not allowed to bring balloons or skateboards on the bus.
- Students who bring baseball/softball bats to school must keep them in a fully enclosed bag with no part visible on the outside.
- All belongings must fit under the student’s feet or on their lap, and in their half of the seat.
- Students are to remain in their seats until the bus comes to a complete stop.
- Headphones/Earbuds must be removed when getting on/off the bus.

****If a student does not ride the bus for 5 consecutive days, they risk losing their bus riding privileges and their stop may be removed from the route.***

****The administrative team reserves the right to deny bus privileges to any student.***
