Final Summary of Legislation Supported by NVCCA

AB 96—requires heat mitigation as part of urban planning in Clark and Washoe. We are pleased to see dedicated attention to heat response in our cities. Signed by Gov

AB256--sets up a regional rail transit advisory commission. Accessible and convenient public transportation is essential for reducing transportation emissions. Public transportation is also healthy! Cities with successful public transit have less obesity, diabetes, hypertension and fewer traffic fatalities. Signed by Gov

AB452—requires fuel cost sharing by NVE. Signed by Gov (check Nevada Conservation League publicity)

AB458—allows solar net metering on multifamily affordable housing. Signed by Gov (check NV Clean Energy Fund, Nevada Conservation League, American Lung Association for publicity).

SB132—\$500,000 operations grant for NCEF. Signed by Gov (check NV Clean Energy Fund for publicity)

SB442—requires NVE to report on disconnections. Passed both houses. Signed by Gov. (Check Make the Road NV, NV Conservation League for publicity)

AB414--occupational protection against truck idling emissions at large loading docks (like the convention center). Passed both houses. Vetoed by Gov

SB260—Requires establishment of state regulations for employer monitoring and communication to employees for protection against wildfire smoke exposure in the workplace. Signed by Gov
