**CLASSROOM MANAGEMENT BEST PRACTICES:** The next several weeks are very busy with end of year preparations (field days, family celebrations, EOG proctoring  $\bigcirc$ , etc.) and the energy in your classrooms can be extra charged. Here are some helpful tips to remember as we navigate the next few weeks:

- \*\*Keep the daily schedule as consistent as possible. Structure is vital for students to feel safe and secure. Safe and secure students = appropriate behaviors exhibited.
- \*\*Keep yourself in control. Students pick up on the positive and negative emotions of the adults around them.
- \*\*Keep a variety of instructional materials and purposeful activities in Interest Areas at all times. Busy minds & bodies don't have time to exhibit challenging behaviors.
- \*\*Continue with your Tier 1 PPM support of <u>recognizing students for their positive behaviors</u> (positive descriptive feedback, sunshines, class incentives, etc.)

**TRANSITION REPORTS:** TSG has a quick video explanation of how to complete the transition form. It should pop up as you open TSG and can help you confidently complete them for your students.

A few things you need to know about the transition reports:

- They are not to be shared with families.
- They are accessible on the **state level** and will be shared with their Kindergarten teacher. (Use your revision/editing tools to check for correct grammar, punctuation, and spelling!)
- You will have the ability to include notes for the Kindergarten teacher, but it is
  not required that all students have a personal note. Do include any 'red flags'
  that the teacher should be made aware such as:
  - Attendance issues
  - Academic concerns that may need to be addressed early
  - Social-emotional concerns
  - Strategies you used that worked to support the student academically, socially-emotionally or physically.
