
Pay and Credit Eligibility:

The [JCPS Board published Salary Schedules](#) state that presentation and preparation pay is agreed upon in the JCTA contract for Teachers, Resource Teachers, and Librarians in Job Family III. It is recommended that no more than 3 people present at a single session.

It also states that Certified and Classified Administrators are not eligible for extra service pay during their work year with the exception of winter, spring, and summer breaks.

Presentation Pay:

Teacher and librarian presenters can be paid their hourly rate for presentations. They cannot receive any PD credit if they are being paid. To receive pay or credit, they must have the required amount of PD hours for that time of year.

Presentation Credit:

Presenters may receive credit for their presentation. One hour of PD presentation equals one hour of PD credit. Presenters cannot receive any pay if they are receiving credit.

Preparation Pay:

Teacher and librarian presenters can be paid for preparing a session the first time they present it. They are paid three hours maximum for every hour at the rate of \$22.3537. Presenters can only receive preparation pay or credit; they cannot receive both. Employees must present the session to be eligible for preparation pay.

Preparation Credit:

Teacher and librarian presenters can receive credit for preparing a session the first time they present it. They can receive three hours of preparation for every hour they present. There is a six hour maximum for any event. Presenters can only receive preparation pay or credit; they cannot receive both. Employees must present the session to be eligible for preparation pay.
