5 mins	Set up the video to watch. Students seated on the floor.	
5 mins	Introduction:	
	Introduce the topic - Sports	
	Today we are learning the Auslan signs for some common sports. You may play or watch these sports at home. You will notice that many of these sports look like what they are (iconic), e.g. tennis, cricket, rugby, basketball and netball. This will help you remember them as you learn and practise them. Teachers discuss this with students when they see the signs.	
	<ul> <li>(Start of Lesson)</li> <li>Read and discuss the Learning Intention and Success Criteria.</li> <li>Check for understanding, clarifying vocabulary as necessary.</li> </ul>	
10 mins	Explicit Teaching: Watch the video	Lesson 31 video
	Use teacher discretion to decide if the class needs to watch any part of the video a second time.	
	Signs taught: Sport, ball, soccer, football, basketball, tennis, rugby, netball, cricket, athletics, swimming, team, win, lose.	
5 mins	<ul> <li>Explanation of Activity:</li> <li>Identify the Sport:</li> <li>Students sit in a circle with 'sport' pictures turned face downwards in the centre. A student or the teacher turns a picture. A selected student identifies the picture by using the Auslan sign. Ask the other students, "Are they correct?" If not, another student signs. Take turns until all the pictures have been turned.</li> <li>Quick discussion regarding the sports that the students or their siblings might play or watch at home. What are your family favourites? To include all, each student</li> </ul>	

	can quickly sign which sport they play or watch.	
15 mins	<ul> <li>Activity:</li> <li>Identify the sport - match sign to the sporting picture</li> <li>Discussion re students' own sports and family favourites.</li> </ul>	Links Below: Sign Reference Sheet Activity Sports Pictures
5 mins	<ul> <li>Reflection with Students: (Select from the following)</li> <li>Which sports signs remind you of/look like the sport?</li> <li>Which sign was your favourite to do? Why?</li> <li>Explain using Auslan which sports you or your family play/watch?</li> <li>Have you been to watch a special sporting game or event?</li> </ul>
